Inflation Watch

On Thursday, July 15, the Bureau of Labor Statistics released the Producer Price Indexes for the month of June 2004. On Friday, June 16, the Bureau of Labor Statistics released the Consumer Price Indexes for the month of June 2004.

* New * This month, we have added the Personal Consumption Indexes to our Inflation Watch. Due to the release schedule of these statistics, the PCE tables/charts will lag one month at the time of the initial release of our Inflation Watch. We will update these statistics when they are released near the end of the month.

The following tables contain statistics on the Consumer Price Index (including the Median CPI), the Producer Price Index, the Personal Consumption Expenditure Index, and various sub-indexes and special indexes of all three.

Consumer Price Inflation

The Consumer Price Index rose **3.27%** from June 2003 to June 2004.

Within the eight major sub-groups:

Three are growing faster than the base rate. These groups comprise **38.34%** of the index:

- Transportation (5.36%)
- Medical Care (4.66%)
- Food and Beverages (3.66%)

Five are growing slower than the base rate. These groups comprise only **61.66%** of the index:

- Housing (2.60%)
- Education and communication (2.29%)
- Other Goods and Services (1.95%)
- Recreation (1.21%)
- Apparel (0.75%)

The commonly watched special index, all items less food and energy (or "core rate"), rose **1.87%** in the June to June period.

Many prefer to watch the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland's Median CPI as a better measure of the "core rate." This index rose 2.32% June over June.

Two other special indices are worth notice in the June over June period. The energy index rose 16.37% while the energy commodities index rose 30.64%.

Personal Consumption Expenditures

In the year ending **June** 2004, the PCE Index increased 2.70%. The "Core" PCE Index (less food and energy) increased by 1.77%. Also of interest is the difference between the 12-month growth rate of Durable Goods (-1.27%), Non-Durable Goods (4.61%), and Services (2.64%). Most of this difference can be attributed to the hedonic adjustments incorporated in Durable Goods.

Producer Price Inflation

In the twelve months ending June 2004, the Producer Price Index for Finished Goods **increased 4.14%**, the Producer Price Index for Intermediate Goods **increased 6.91%**, the Producer Price Index for Crude materials **rose 18.78%** and the Producer Price Index for Commodities **rose 6.59%**.

Charts - Comparing CPI and PCE

The charts on the next page compare the year-over-year changes of CPI and PCE. They show that PCE typically has a year-over-year change that is less than CPI (which might account for why the Fed prefers this measure). However, even the PCE indices have moved sharply higher in recent months. Like CPI, the PCE indices have 6-month and 3-month annualized growth rates well above their year-over-year changes (meaning inflation is still accelerating).

All these numbers are well above the current Federal Funds target rate of 1.25%. So, no matter how inflation is measured, it is well above the funds rate and suggests the Fed will be raising rates for some time to come.



